
Schools & Teachers/Trainers Surveys Purpose



DEMOGRAPHIC RESULTS



In the survey applied to a total of 24 teachers from 5 countries, including the project partners, the highest participation rate was found in Romania with 33.3%, Bulgaria with 25%, Turkey with 20.8%, Portugal with 16.7% and Belgium achieved a participation rate of 4.2%.




The current approaches and knowledges of the participant teachers about

- their willingness to use digital education tools as VR and augmented reality


1. Do you think teaching cultural heritage is important at schools?















challenges for participating in out-of-school cultural activities

- 100% of the teachers think teaching cultural heritage is important at schools and 71% of the teachers have familiarities to the educational programs for/through cultural heritage.
- 96% of the teachers are aware of the cultural assets in the places they live. Only one teacher stated that she/he did not recognize the cultural assets in the place where she/he lived.

- Teachers stated that they benefit from various cultural activities as a way of teaching in their lessons. However, one teacher (%4,2) stated that he benefited from all cultural activities, while another teacher (4,2%) stated that he did not benefit from any cultural activities.
- Teachers prefer to teach the cultural activities of Holidays, Music, Visual Arts, Performance Arts, Traditional Food and Architecture, respectively.
- 83% of teachers have awareness any institutions/organisations that work on cultural assets on a national/international scale. However, 70.8% of them have awareness for their activities and 62,5% of them have awareness for the national/international legislation regarding the protection of cultural assets.

- 66.7% of the teachers visit museums within the scope of their lessons, 50% of them do activities such as cinema and theater. Other preferred course activities, respectively, are archaeological site visits, biennial, exhibition, festival and museum activities. Only one of the teachers visited the Architectural Cultural Heritage. One of them does not perform any activity.
- However, all of the teachers (100%) care about the participation of students in cultural activities within the scope of the course.
- In addition, 96% of teachers find it valuable to teach their lessons together with cultural activities.

- All of the teachers (100%) think it is helpful to teach new subjects in a digital environment/platform together with cultural activity.

- All of the teachers (100%) think it is helpful to teach new subjects in a digital environment/platform together with cultural activity.
- 83% of teachers have the ability to easily plan a lesson in which students will attend a cultural event. 4 teachers remained undecided on this issue.
- 67% of teachers struggle with Administrative regulations and paperwork when participating in out-of-school cultural activities with their students. 50% of them have difficulties in transportation, 33% due to lack of time. However, none of the teachers had problems with Parental consent.
