The project "Codes of Cultural Heritage" has just kicked off with its first TPM in the beautiful capital city of Romania–Bucharest, in March 27–29,2023

After the meeting, the project team visited culturally important places in Bucharest and Siania. We were lucky enough to see the Peleş Castle- a Neo-Renaissance palace of Romanian Kings, which is located in the Carpathian Mountains, near Sinaia, in Prahova County, Romania, on an existing medieval route linking Transylvania and Wallachia, built between 1873 and 1914.

During these 3 days, we witnessed the beauty of traditions, costumes, museums, palaces and music in Romania, a perfect start for a cultural heritage project.
