## FINAL TPM IN ISTANBUL

On 24th September 2024, at the Palais des Académies in Brussels, the AEF Europe (Agence francophone pour l'éducation et la formation tout au long de la vie) organized an Erasmus+ Information Morning for Nursery and Primary Schools. During the event, our partner school École fondamentale de Heliport's teacher, Oana Topala, successfully disseminated the Codes of Cultural Heritage Erasmus+ project, presenting the platform and the educational toolkit to 50 teachers from the Fédération Wallonie-Bruxelles.

33 and 18, people participated in two seminars. They were also awarded with certificates of attendance.







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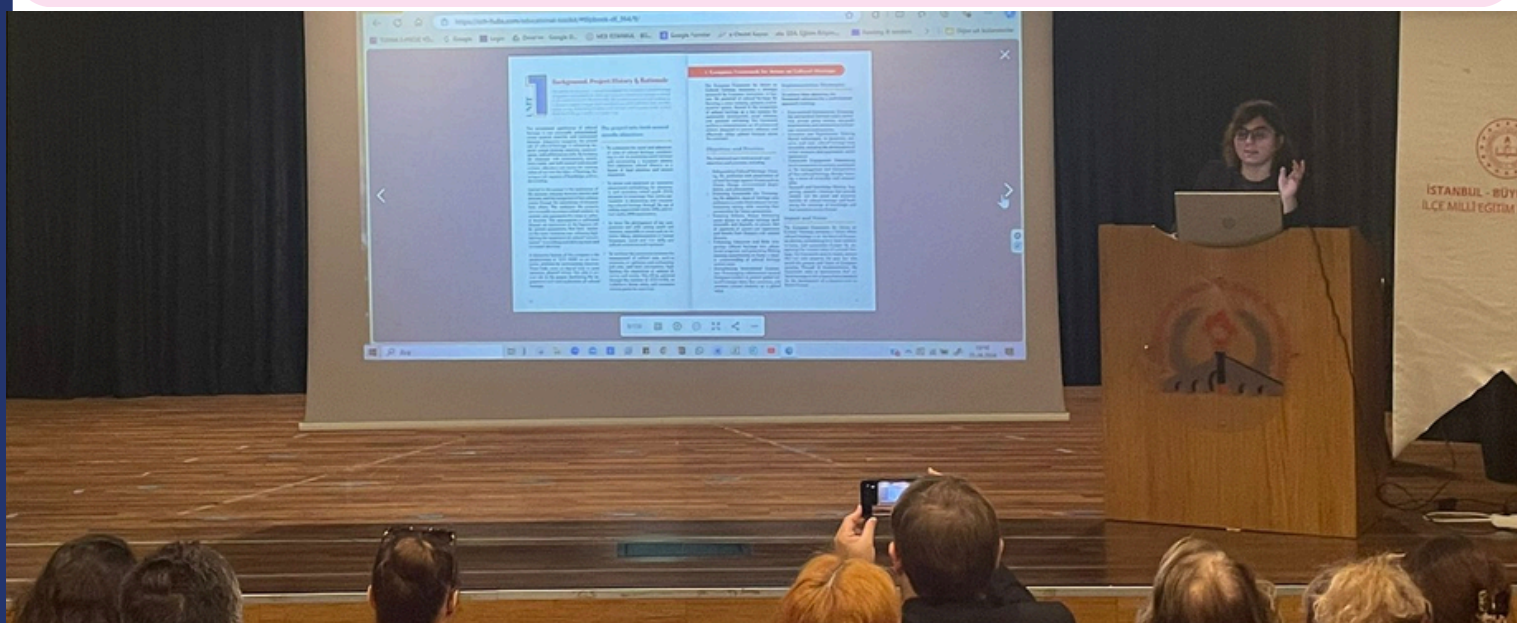


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## MULTIPLIER EVENT: TEACHERS MEETING IN ISTANBUL
